Min01/08/AGM: Opening prayer	Opening prayer was led by Rev. Wilson Wasswa.	
Min02/08/AGM: Adoption of Agenda	The Chairperson welcomed members and presented the agenda. The agenda was adopted and seconded unanimously by the members and the meeting proceeded.	
Min03/08/AGM: Reading of previous minutes	The previous minutes of the 7 th AGM were read by the Executive Director UNNGOF and were adopted as a true record of what transpired in that meeting.	
Min04/08/AGM: Matters Arising	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members appreciated the secretariat's mode of communicating to them on matters concerning the progress of the organisation and also requested to access copies of the National Development Plan since there was the Civil Societies' participation. • On the matter concerning EU Capacity Building Programme, the meeting was informed that the project was officially closed and matters of follow up could be accessed from the Office of the Prime Minister. • Members were concerned that most District NGO Forums were non-functional yet these networks were supposed to champion the work of the NGO Forum for NGOs to benefit. Apparently the secretariat was supporting the District 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The secretariat took note and promised to follow up on this matter. • The end of project report was available at the secretariat and could be availed to the members on request. • The Secretariat to follow up on this matter.

	<p>Networks within the Network for District Network Strategic Programme (NDNSP) and support to other networks could be demand driven as they would have to raise their challenges that could be supported on request and available resources.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The meeting was also informed of the different strategies the secretariat was providing to strengthen the networks like organising the Civil Society Days and other benefiting programmes like the Civil Society Forum and Uwezo. Funding of NDNSP was covering only 25 districts though the fundraising strategy was already seeking ways of increasing this number. • On the issue of any reports from CHOGM regarding UNNGOF representation of the Civil Society Organisations, the meeting was informed that there had been no audit queries from the Parliamentary Accounts Committee (PAC) and thus there was not much to report on this matter. • The members were advised to be more vigilant during elections so as to consider both equality and equity. The board so far was comprised of 4 women out of 13 members. • On the matter concerning members' identification, the meeting was informed that members could only be identified by paying membership subscription and acquiring certificates and also by participating in the several NGO Forum events. • The issue concerning NGO Directors' Forum the members were informed that an annual Directors' Forum/retreat was important to take time and critically reflect on the governance of the NGOs. • Members were also concerned about their participation in the National Planning Authority (NPA) and whether the organisation was represented. They were informed that UNNGOF was already a member of the expanded board of the NPA which showed the Civil Society representation. It still represented them at the governing council of the African Peer Review Mechanism (APRM). • Members were also advised to keep the secretariat informed about their change of their physical addresses and have working e-mail addresses so as to ease the work of the secretariat in communicating to them. • Members further appreciated the work of the secretariat while showing the need for study trips with other developed countries to compare their work with counterparts in other countries. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This was already planned for by the secretariat. • Secretariat to follow up

<p>Min05/08/AGM: Chairperson's report</p>	<p>The chairperson started the presentation of his report to the members by appreciating them for having entrusted the board with the duty of leadership.</p> <p>He informed the members that there were changes on the board. Mr. Augustine Omara who retired from CDRN was now replaced by Dr. Martin Mwondha; the new Chief Executive. This communication came from the organization to the board and requested members to approve him as part of the board.</p> <p>As per the constitution (Article 9 .2 (b) of the UNNGOF Constitution),two people were also chosen to be independent members of the Board i.e Dr. Josephine Ahikire and Dr. Akim Okuni basing on their credibility and experience to take on the duties.</p> <p>He highlighted some of the achievements that included:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Completion of institutional and governance reforms especially in response to the new strategic plan. - Reviewing and updating vital institutional policies that included reviewing the human resource and financial manual that have earned the secretariat more confidence among the donors and development partners. - Fundraising for the organisation in order to deliver the strategic plan in an efficient and effective manner aiming at realizing a stable and sustainable organisation. - Providing strategic guidance in the planning and implementation of programmes. The QuAming of UNNGOF was a key highlight and the QuAM certificate would be presented in a few months. - Embarking on an ambitious process to set up the UNNGOF house. The proposed architectural plan was presented to the members. <p>The chairperson finally thanked the members for their attention and wished the members fruitful deliberations.</p> <p>Reactions and discussion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members unanimously approved and adopted the report for discussion. • They further adopted and approved the appointment of the three new board members i.e. Dr. Martin Mwondha, Dr. Akim Okuni and Dr. Josephine Ahikire. • The members requested for pictorial database of the Board members and the chairperson that would be availed at the 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The secretariat to follow up

	<p>secretariat offices for future reference.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They also showed the need for regular updates and reminders to pay in time that required a formatted database of the members. • Members also presented a need for their work to appear on the UNNGOF website for marketing their services. The secretariat was ready to offer a linkage on the website since it would be so costly to host all the members' profiles. • The meeting was also informed that land for the Forum house was not yet acquired and although there was already a five year budget process for the house there were processes of identifying some donors who would be able to support the initiative. • On the issue of the National Social Forum, the meeting was informed that the strategic plan passed that the secretariat should not be in charge of the Social Forums but arrange for Civil Society days. • Members who requested for their particular groups to be distinctly recognised were informed that this was a constitutional issue that required amendment. Furthermore, reports from the thematic groups could not be discussed in the AGM since this was a general meeting. • On the issue of fundraising, the meeting was informed that fundraising also would come along with a cost so it is important to reflect on creating a sustainable way of supporting the programmes and not relying on donors. • On the matter of upcoming elections, members discussed that it was important to organise workshops to sensitise people about election process. • Clarification on the support to the institutions how the members of the organisation benefit was also cleared showing that UNNGOF was not a funding organisation thus money mobilised is for programmes which support members apart from NDNISP that directly funds 25 districts networks it operates in. • The meeting was made to understand that visits to members would be continuous though they may not cover all members, it would be complimented by the CSO days. • The meeting also discussed an emphasis of QuAM after congratulating the NGO Forum upon the certification. Min06/08/AGM: Treasurer's report	<p>The treasurer presented her report showing the activities that were taken in the past year that were also audited. She presented the chart of accounts that presented the cash and bank balances available in the organization. This showed the cash inflow and outflows which portrayed an increase in the inflows that reflected the effective work of the secretariat.</p> <p>Some of the challenges included the need for more staffing for efficient work and the membership subscription which was still low that affected the cash inflow.</p> <p>She concluded the presentation by requesting the approval of B.V.L and co. as the new auditors for UNNGOF.</p> <p>Reactions from the treasurer's report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members appreciated the increase in cash flow and good budget control and also the work of the auditors which was efficient. They commended the board fundraising strategy that increased the cash inflow and thanked the E.D for inter linkage with government and the fact that DANIDA channelled its support to the organisation. • Members requested the secretariat for information and visiting them regularly to help with fundraising ideas. • Members were concerned that funds going into operational expenses were higher than those going into the support to the members. This was rectified that the organisation was incurring more costs on programmes than operations and advised to trust the board to supervise the operations of the secretariat. • Members also requested that the audit and financial reports to be availed to them at least two weeks before AGM for proper scrutiny. • Members were informed that the board has come up with a strategy of fundraising for the UNGGOF house and it would be communicated to members • They also got clarification about the variances since some funds came in late in the year as sent from donors. <p>The meeting gave the former Chairperson opportunity to share with them. She congratulated the board for the far they had gone in fulfilling the work of Strategic Plan.
